

Information for Illustrations in Diacritics

FORMAL REQUIREMENTS

Images can be black&white or color.

All images need to be provided as high-resolution image files (typically jpg or tiff) with a resolution of **at least 300 dpi**.

Images for the art portfolio must be suitable for reproduction in a size of about 8x11 inches; images meant to be integrated into individual essays must be suitable for reproduction in a size of about 4x6 inches.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

If you send more than one image, please do not send them as image attachments to an email, but rather use a file-sharing platform of your choice and send us the download link.

Please label the images clearly (by number and/or title) and send a list of image captions in a separate Word file along with the images.

Image captions should include:

- number (especially if you want the images to appear in a specific order)
- title
- artist and/or photographer
- year of production
- materials (if applicable)
- copyright (if applicable)

COPYRIGHT REQUIREMENTS

Authors are responsible for sorting out the copyright/reproduction permission for the images they want to use.

Diacritics does not have a budget to pay for image reproduction rights.

If the copyright holder requires information about the distribution of the images in question, you can share the following information with them:

The issue will appear both in print (with a print run of ca. 300 copies) and online (via Project Muse, with an estimated 1000 views per essay during the first year).

The cover image will be used also to advertise the issue on the Diacritics website and the JHUP website as well as on social media.
